what is airAlert?

airAlert is a free service provided by Southampton City Council's Environmental Health Service and Southampton Primary Care Trust to help improve the lives of those who are affected by air pollution.

airAlert can help you manage your health

Those affected by asthma, other respiratory illnesses and heart conditions can find their health is affected by poor air quality.

airAlert is a free text, voicemail, e-mail and web service that sends you air pollution alerts when levels in your area increase to a moderate level or above.

airAlerts are sent out on the day before moderate levels are forecast. The service allows you to receive alerts for different locations (i.e home or work).

airAlert is particularly valuable for those who have chronic respiratory disease or whose asthma is triggered by air pollution.

What should I do when I receive an airAlert?

- Avoid areas where pollution increases are likely.
- Be active, but consider alternative activities for the period of an alert.
- Don't forget your inhaler or medication.
- Contact your health professional if your symptoms worsen or if you require specialist advice concerning your condition.



what can I expect from airAlert?

airAlert messages let you know the predicted levels of pollution in your area.

airAlert message

These are the type of messages you will receive. These messages reflect government advice on air pollution levels.



Moderate air pollution levels

those at risk may notice mild effects but these are unlikely to need action.



High air pollution levels

those at risk may notice significant effects and may need to take action.



Very high air pollution levels

the effects on those at risk, described for 'high' alerts, may worsen.

The airAlert will detail:

- The level of concern; Moderate, High or Very High.
- The type of pollution ozone (O₃), particles/dust (PM₁₀), nitrogen dioxide (NO₂).
- Where the pollution is of most concern (e.g. roadside, non-roadside, rural, urban).
- Date and period of the alert.

how do I sign up?

airAlert is a completely free service available to all those who would benefit from air pollution alerts.

There are 3 easy ways to sign up:

1. Registering **online** at www.airalert.info
2. Calling us on **023 8083 3005 (select option 4)** and we will register for you
3. **Completing and returning the attached form**

Once you have signed up we will send you a welcome message. airAlert runs all year but messages will only be sent out when pollution levels increase to a moderate level or above.
